Refund Policy: The applicant agrees to the following: 30 days written notice of termination of membership with the club must be supplied which includes skaters last days, at which point a refund less the \$31 Skate Canada Registration Fee and \$50 Administration Fee can be issued. If 30 days notice is not given, pro-rated days from the date of termination will be refunded less the Skate Canada Fee and Admin fee. All skating credits are non-refundable without appropriate skating related receipts. In the event of any injury or accident the appropriate portion of the registration fee will be refunded if the request is accompanied by a doctor's certificate. No refund will be given if a student leaves by his/her own accord or is expelled by the Club. No refunds or make up sessions missed due to illness, holidays, competitions, tests, maintenance or management disputes.

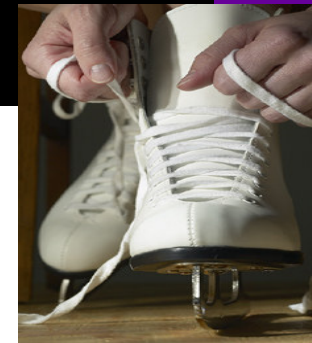

Preliminary Prep

Preliminary Prep:

The program introduces the skater to the fundamental skills necessary to begin either a recreational or competitive figure skating career. The class also tests the participants on these beginning skills through the 5-7 Stages. Badges are awarded for passing each level.

- All Ages
- Must be working on Level 5 badge and at the recommendation of a professional Coach
- Mandatory 2 days per week
- Skaters have the option to pick up extra practice ice on Tues or Thurs at 3:45–4:45 pm

Music:

To help assist the coaches on the ice, parents are required to help play the music. A music cheque is required at the beginning of the season which will be cashed. A music schedule will be completed and each parent is responsible for making sure their shifts are filled. Once all music shifts are completed money is returned or put in a club account for the skater.

Group STARSkate

Group StarSkate:

Offers opportunities for skaters of all ages to develop advance figure skating skills in all disciplines: skating skills, free skate and ice dancing. Unique in Canada, this program teaches figure skating skills in a group format, in a progressive and sequential manner and includes specifically designed awards and incentives.

- Private lessons are available at an additional costs to the skater and alternative arrangements must be made by the Skaters.
- Skater have the opportunity to take Skate Canada Tests through a nationally standardized testing system as well as compete in different competition if desires. Once the skater has passed all Prelim Dances and Skills, they will move up into the Star Skate or Competitive stream. This is at the coach's discretion.
- Mandatory 2 days per week
- Skaters have the option to pick up extra practice ice on Tues or Thurs at 3:45–4:45 pm
