Registration Agreement:

- Applications will not be processed and skaters will not be allowed on the ice without all registration/ fundraising forms complete, and cheques received for registration & fundraising (as applicable)
- A \$30 fee will be charged on dishonored (NSF) cheques
- Airdrie Skating Club members have first choice of sessions until September 5, 2008
- Income Tax Receipts will be provided by February 28, 2008.
- Parents cannot participate on the ice unless asked to do so and are registered with Skate Canada
- All parents are required to fulfill fundraising requirements for as per the Fundraising/Volunteer Commitment agreement.
- All parents are required to play music. An orientation session will be held in October to acquaint parents with the music system. Music plays required will be based on the number of participants in the program. Music cheques will be cashed and credits will be reflected in the statement at the end of the season for all members who have fulfilled their commitment. Extra plays will be credited at a rate of \$10/play.
