Registration Agreement:

- Applications will not be processed and skaters will not be allowed on the ice without all registration/ fundraising forms complete, and cheques received for registration & fundraising (as applicable)
- A \$30 fee will be charged on dishonored (NSF) cheques
- Airdrie Skating Club members have first choice of sessions until September 5, 2008
- Income Tax Receipts will be provided by February 28, 2009.
- Parents cannot participate on the ice unless asked to do so and are registered with Skate Canada
- All parents are required to fulfill fundraising requirements as per the Fundraising/Volunteer Commitment agreement.
- Coaches bills must be kept up to date or registration may be withheld, club membership may be terminated, and lessons will be discontinued.
- All parents are required to play music, an orientation session will be held in October to acquaint parents with the music system. Music plays required will be based on the number of participants in the program. Music cheques will be cashed and credits will be reflected in the statement at the end of the season for all members who have fulfilled their commitment. Extra plays will be credited at a rate of \$10/play.

Liability Waiver and Release: It is understood and agreed, as a condition of participation in skating programs offered by the Airdrie Skating Club and Skate Canada, that neither the Club nor Skate Canada shall be liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by the above-noted member while traveling to or from or while participating in skating practices, competitions or other activities however caused. The member, or his/her parent/legal guardian, who has signed this form, shall indemnify the club and Skate Canada and hold them harmless from any claims, demands or actions arising from or in respect of such injury, loss or damage. *In the event of an injury or accident, and the Airdrie Skating Club is unable to contact the "contact persons" above, I/we give permission for the coaches to arrange for medical help. I/We agree to cover any and all expenses and costs related to the injury/accident.*

FOIP: In accordance with the Freedom of Information and Privacy Act, I give the Airdrie Skating Club permission to publish my child's name and/or photo on arena bulletin boards, trophies, carnival programs, newsletters, newspapers and any other areas pertaining to the "skating world".

Refund Policy: The applicant agrees to the following: 30 days written notice of termination of membership with the club must be supplied which includes skaters last days, at which point a refund less the \$31 Skate Canada Registration Fee and \$50 Administration Fee can be issued. If 30 days notice is not given, pro-rated days from the date of termination will be refunded less the Skate Canada Fee and Admin fee. All skating credits are non-refundable without appropriate skating related receipts. In the event of any injury or accident the appropriate portion of the registration fee will be refunded if the request is accompanied by a doctor's certificate. No refund will be given if a student leaves by his/her own accord or is expelled by the Club. No refunds or make up sessions missed due to illness, holidays, competitions, tests, maintenance or management disputes.

Extreme Weather Policy: ASC weather policy to be set at a temperature of -35 w/wind chill ALL Ice Programs will be cancelled. No make-up sessions will be scheduled and no refunds.
